



Personality

The Big Five: Using the definitions below, take a stab at where you think you would land on each spectrum. There are no right or wrong answers; this will simply help you understand yourself and others around you a little better.



Openness to New Experiences: Are you typically original, creative, curious, complex? Or do you tend to be conventional, down to earth, more narrow interests, less creative.

Conscientiousness: Do you tend to be reliable, well-organized, self-disciplined, cautious? Or are you more spontaneous, go with the flow and nonchalant, less organized?

Extraversion: Are you typically sociable, friendly, talkative, and energized by people? Or would you describe yourself as more introverted, reserved, quiet, or energized by being alone?

Supportiveness: Are you most often good-natured, sympathetic, forgiving, courteous? Or are you often critical, analytical, abrupt, rigid?

Emotional Stability: Would you probably be described as nervous, highstrung, insecure, prone to worry? Or calm, relaxed, even keel, resilient?
