7. What do you learn about the character and heart of God from this deliverance of his people and his provisions for them on their journey?

8. In what ways do John 1:29, Romans 5:9, I Corinthians 5:7 and I Peter 1:19 help you see Jesus in this chapter of the story?

- 9. God challenged Moses to lead his people and his people to follow. What is God challenging you to do right now?
- 10. What are the false gods in your life that you're trading for the one true, mighty God? Are you trading the one true, mighty God for a cheap imitation?
- 11. Read Exodus 13:3. What miracles has God done in your life? How can you commemorate them?
