Israel (northern kingdom) → <u>Assyrian</u> empire 722 B.C. Judah (southern kingdom) → <u>Babylonian</u> empire 586 B.C.

REJECTING & REPENTING (II Chronicles 33-34)

Manasseh: evil King of Judah... became king at age 12

"The LORD spoke to Manasseh and his people, but they paid no attention. So the LORD brought against them the army commanders of the king of Assyria..."

<u>Josiah</u>: righteous King of Judah... became king at age 8

"He did what was right in the eyes of the LORD and followed the ways of his father David, not turning aside to the right or to the left."
