Digging Deeper

- 3. Read Mark 8:27-30 and Matthew 16:13-20 together. Why do you think it was important for Jesus to ask them who they thought he was? Why do you think Peter recognized Jesus as the Messiah?
- 4. Read Matthew 17:1-13. Jesus chose Peter, James and John to witness this incredible transfiguration. Why do you think he brought them with him? During the Transfiguration, God proclaimed Jesus as his Son. If you witnessed this, how would it impact your understanding of who Jesus is?
- 5. In John 7:12-13; 25-27 we see that there was widespread whispering about him. People were trying to figure out who he was. Why do you think such a stir occurred? Why were they whispering?

- 6. Let's each take one of the following "I AM" statements and discuss who Jesus says he is: How do these dimensions of Jesus' identity impact your understanding of Jesus for your life today?
 - "I am the bread of Life" (John 6:25-29)
 - "I am the light of the world" (John 8:12-20; 9:1-7)
 - "Before Abraham was born, I am" (John 8:52-59)
 - "I am the gate for the sheep" (John 10:1-10)
 - "I am the good shepherd" (John 10:11-18)
 - "I am God's Son" (John 10:32-38; 14:10-11)
 - "I am the resurrection and the life" (John 11:21-27)
 - "I am the way and the truth and the life" (John 14:5-6)
 - "I am the true vine" (John 15:1-5)

Where Do I Go from Here?

"You must make your choice. Either this man was, and is, the Son of God: or else a madman or something worse.
