The tenets of the Gospel can be seen clearly on the 'Romans Road' (scripture verses found in the book of Romans that show our need and God's grace). Discuss and pray through these verses. Ask your Guide if you don't understand something about this message. If you know Jesus, practice sharing the meaning of these passages, so you may clearly explain the good news of Jesus to those who do not know Him.

The Roman Road

Romans 3:23 (also 3:10-12): All have sinned and fall short of God's glory.

Romans 6:23: The punishment for sin is death, but the gift of God is life.

Romans 5:8: Because God loves us, He took the punishment for our sin.

Romans 10:9-10: Confess and believe to be saved (justified).

Romans 10:13: All who call on God shall be saved.

Romans 12:1-2: As we surrender to Jesus, his Spirit will transform us more into his likeness.

Prayer

Ask God to open the hearts of specific people in your life who do not know Jesus. Ask God to use you to plant the seeds of salvation in the same way that Paul did with so many. Thank God for the work He is doing in and through you!
