By helping people:



- 2. Selfless **unity**: We lay down our preferences and celebrate our diverse strengths for the sake of the mission (Ephesians 4:2-7, 11-13; John 17:20-23).
- 3. Holy **hunger**: We desire more of God for ourselves, our church, our community, and our world (Matthew 5:6; John 14:12).
- 4. Overflowing **generosity**: We are lavish in our gratitude and giving ourselves away because of God's abundant grace to us (II Corinthians 8:2; I Timothy 6:17-19).
- 5. Contagious **joy**: We live enthusiastically for Jesus in such a way that others are drawn to him (Matthew 28:8; Philippians 4:4-5).
